It's the month of Valentine's Day and love is in the air. It's time for hearts, flowers, and dare I say, copious amounts of chocolate. Is that what love is really all about? Unity defines Divine Love as the power to act from love in every circumstance, both good and difficult; to seek harmony in all situations and see beyond the appearance of separation. How can we understand the depth and range of feelings wrapped up in one word: LOVE?

The ancient Greeks in their pursuit of wisdom and self-understanding found seven types of Love

- 1. Eros (Erotic Love). Eros is the Greek god of love and fertility. Eros represents sexual passion and desire. It is a primal and powerful fire that burns out quickly.
- 2. "Philia" (Affectionate Love). Philia is also known as friendship or shared goodwill. The ancient Greeks valued philia above Eros because it was a love between equals platonic love.
- 3. Storge (Familial Love). Storge pertains to the love between parents and their children; the "unconditional love" at the first sight of our newborn.
- 4. Philautia (Self Love). Philautia, unlike Narcissism, is self-love in its healthiest form. It shares the Buddhist tenant of self-compassion.
- 5. Ludus (Playful Love). Ludus is a playful or uncommitted love. The focus is on fun. Ludus relationships are casual and undemanding.
- 6. Pragma (Enduring Love). Pragma is a love that has matured and developed over time. We find Pragma in couples that have been together for a long time, or in friendships that have endured and have developed patience and tolerance.
- 7. Agape (Selfless Love). The highest and most radical type of love. A universal love; for strangers, nature or God. Some consider this love altruism. It is what the Buddhists describe as "metta" or "universal loving kindness".

Thanks to the ancient Greeks, we can learn, meditate and affirm all the types of love in our lives. Love truly is what the world needs now.
